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The Principal, Muthiah Polytechnic, Annamalainagar  
who has been appointed as Inspecting Officer in this office  
letter first cited has submitted his report in the reference  
third cited.

The Inspecting Officer among other things has reported  
that the Polytechnic is now housed in a private building  
with sufficient facilities to run the first year classes.

Further he has also reported that you have provided  
only a portion of equipments required for the Physics  
and Chemistry laboratories. He has also reported that  
you have already ordered for ~~xxxx~~ procuring the balance of  
equipments.

The Inspecting Officer has also recommended that the  
facilities now provided by you is sufficient to start the  
I Year of the Polytechnic from the academic year 1986-87.

In view of the above, provisional permission is accorded  
to your Society to start the Annai Velankanni Polytechnic,  
Anguchettipalayam, Panrutti and run the first year classes for  
the academic year 1986-87 subject to the following condi-  
tions.

- i. The Management should make necessary arrangement  
to move the Polytechnic to its original cite  
within one year from the date of the issue of  
this letter.

- ii. The management should provide all the infra-structural facilities to the required standards.
- iii. The management should fulfil all the conditions stipulated by the Government in their G.O. cited.


Further, I specifically inform that if you fail to fulfil the above conditions, the Government will be addressed for the disapproval of your institution.

Permission is also hereby granted to ~~you~~ run the Polytechnic temporarily for a period of one year in the address given below, as requested in your letter cited.
